- ☐ Make sure your contact information (phone, email, address, etc.) are up to date. **DO NOT BLOCK SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS** or you may not receive emergency notifications. ☐ SHUSD advocates the RUN, HIDE, or FIGHT emergency response and as such post emergency reunification locations may vary. ☐ Wait for communication and directions through ParentSquare (text, email, and voice). Although understandably compelled, please try NOT to go to your child's school. An emergency operations and communications location will be established by the police. Location(s) TBD. □ ONLY pick-up your child when and where directed and safe to do so.
