E. DISTRICT ENROLLMENT PROCESS - UPDATE

Superintendent Aurelio presented on District enrollment and wants the board to address two questions when discussing.

Do we as a District want to increase student enrollment? Survey was sent to staff and Staff (74.3%) would like to see an increase in enrollment. Summary of Comments sent via Staff survey on questions presented to staff. Discussed our current enrollment options

- Allen Bill
- Inter-district Agreement only under certain extraordinary circumstances.
- District of Choice (DOC) this is the one that is used the most in our District.

Superintendent Aurelio presented on the History of DOC in SHUSD. DOC Funding has decreased since we adopted and some students funding is based on categorial programs. Our current window for DOC is open until November 30th. Pros and Cons were discussed to consider for District of Choice.

Pros and cons were presented for inter-district permit process items to consider.

Trustee Wolf asked if for this year the deadline of Nov. 30th is a hard deadline and the answer is yes.

Trustee Moura asked about the recommendation of the Allen Bill and all of these are staff related.

Trustee Symon asked about the funding per pupil from the funding we get from DOC (\$180K). This could be anywhere from \$2000-\$2500 per student.

Trustee Kerr asked if we could estimate funding and set aside for students who may need it. Dr. Vang said she needs actual costs for the budget.

Trustee Kerr also mentioned that we need to be a good neighbor. The surrounding school districts have to be struggling with declining enrollment and we could be taking students from other Districts that hurt their numbers more.

Trustee Moura stated that we can control how many students we let in by caps.

Trustee Pelosi is fine with increasing enrollment as long as can cover our other costs as mentioned tonight, deferred maintenance and yearly salary increases.

Trustee Symon stated that the enrollment study stated that we need affordable housing to increase enrollment.

There is a consensus with the board to increase enrollment. Superintendent Aurelio will present the board with a recommendation of caps. Trustee Moura would like to know 6-12 the number of students in core classes.

President Pelosi stated that we have no data on behavioral issues with DOC. Where with IDA's we can set parameters (grades, behaviors, tardies, etc.)

The question was posed if we went to IDA's can our current DOC students Districts revoke their IDA or do they get to remain. More research needs to be done.

The Governing Board will receive an updated presentation in December.
